BANP (H-129): sc-292634



The Power to Question

BACKGROUND

BANP (BTG3 associated nuclear protein), also known as BEND1, SMARBP1 or SMAR1, is a 519 amino acid protein that localizes to the nucleus and belongs to the BANP/SMAR1 family. Interacting with CDP and p53, BANP functions to control V(D)J recombination during T-cell development, specifically by binding to a scaffold/matrix DNA attachment region and repressing the enhancer function of TCR β (T-cell receptor β). Additionally, BANP promotes p53 serine phosphorylation, resulting in the subsequent nuclear accumulation of p53 and, ultimately, cell cycle arrest. BANP is down regulated in breast cancer cells, suggesting a role in tumor suppression. Three isoforms of BANP exist due to alternative splicing events.

Genetic locus: BANP (human) mapping to 16q24.2; Banp (mouse) mapping to 8 E1.

BANP (H-129) is a rabbit polyclonal antibody raised against amino acids 211-339 mapping within an internal region of BANP of human origin.

STORAGE

Store at 4° C, **DO NOT FREEZE**. Stable for one year from the date of shipment. Non-hazardous. No MSDS required.

PRODUCT

Each vial contains 200 μg IgG in 1.0 ml of PBS with <0.1% sodium azide and 0.1% gelatin.

APPLICATIONS

BANP (H-129) is recommended for detection of BANP of mouse, rat and human origin by Western Blotting (starting dilution 1:200, dilution range 1:100-1:1000), immunoprecipitation [1-2 µg per 100-500 µg of total protein (1 ml of cell lysate)], immunofluorescence (starting dilution 1:50, dilution range 1:50-1:500) and solid phase ELISA (starting dilution 1:30, dilution range 1:30-1:3000).

BANP (H-129) is also recommended for detection of BANP in additional species, including equine, canine, bovine, porcine and avian.

Suitable for use as control antibody for BANP siRNA (h): sc-72607, BANP siRNA (m): sc-72608, BANP shRNA Plasmid (h): sc-72607-SH, BANP shRNA Plasmid (m): sc-72608-SH, BANP shRNA (h) Lentiviral Particles: sc-72607-V and BANP shRNA (m) Lentiviral Particles: sc-72608-V.
