The Power to Question

BACKGROUND

PRRG2 (proline-rich γ -carboxyglutamic acid protein 2), also known as PRGP2 or TMG2 (transmembrane γ -carboxyglutamic acid protein 2), is a 202 amino acid single-pass type I membrane protein that is widely expressed, with highest levels found in thyroid. PRRG2 contains an N-terminal propeptide sequence that allows for vitamin K-dependent g-carboxylation of various glutamic acid residues, followed by an N-terminal Gla (γ -carboxy-glutamate) domain and transmembrane region. PRRG2 has a proline-rich C-terminus with PPXY and PXXP motifs. The gene encoding PRRG2 maps to human chromosome 19, which consists of over 63 million bases, houses approximately 1,400 genes and is recognized for having the greatest gene density of the human chromosomes. It is the genetic home for a number of immunoglobulin (Ig) superfamily members, including the killer cell and leukocyte Ig-like receptors, a number of ICAMs, the CEACAM and PSG family and Fc receptors (FcRs).

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CHROMOSOMAL LOCATION

Genetic locus: PRRG2 (human) mapping to 19q13.33; Prrg2 (mouse) mapping to 7 B4.

SOURCE

PRRG2 (H-60) is a rabbit polyclonal antibody raised against amino acids 81-140 mapping within an internal region of PRRG2 of human origin.

PRODUCT

Each vial contains 200 μg lgG in 1.0 ml of PBS with < 0.1% sodium azide and 0.1% gelatin.

APPLICATIONS

PRRG2 (H-60) is recommended for detection of PRRG2 of mouse, rat and human origin by Western Blotting (starting dilution 1:200, dilution range 1:100-1:1000), immunoprecipitation [1-2 µg per 100-500 µg of total protein (1 ml of cell lysate)], immunofluorescence (starting dilution 1:50, dilution range 1:50-1:500) and solid phase ELISA (starting dilution 1:30, dilution range 1:30-1:3000).

PRRG2 (H-60) is also recommended for detection of PRRG2 in additional species, including equine, canine and porcine.
