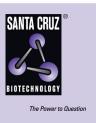

# KIF2C (N-14): sc-30276



# BACKGROUND

Kinesin family member 2c (KIF2C), alternately known as mitotic centromereassociated kinesin (MCAK), is a member of the kinesin-like family of proteins. KIF2C is a cytoplasmic and nuclear protein, present throughout the cell cycle. KIF2C associates with the centromere early in prophase, and disassociates after telophase. KIF2C is abundant in thymus and testis, and present at lower levels in small intestine, the mucosal lining of the colon, and placenta. Human KIF2C maps to chromosome 1p34.1.

# CHROMOSOMAL LOCATION

Genetic locus: KIF2C (human) mapping to 1p34.1; Kif2c (mouse) mapping to 4 D1.

## SOURCE

KIF2C (N-14) is an affinity purified goat polyclonal antibody raised against a peptide mapping near the C-terminus of KIF2C of human origin.

# PRODUCT

Each vial contains 200  $\mu g$  lgG in 1.0 ml of PBS with < 0.1% sodium azide and 0.1% gelatin.

Blocking peptide available for competition studies, sc-30276 P, (100  $\mu$ g peptide in 0.5 ml PBS containing < 0.1% sodium azide and 0.2% BSA).

# **APPLICATIONS**

KIF2C (N-14) is recommended for detection of KIF2C of mouse, rat and human origin by Western Blotting (starting dilution 1:200, dilution range 1:100-1:1000), immunofluorescence (starting dilution 1:50, dilution range 1:50-1:500) and solid phase ELISA (starting dilution 1:30, dilution range 1:30-1:3000).

KIF2C (N-14) is also recommended for detection of KIF2C in additional species, including equine, canine, bovine and porcine.

Suitable for use as control antibody for KIF2C siRNA (h): sc-105596, KIF2C siRNA (m): sc-146476, KIF2C shRNA Plasmid (h): sc-105596-SH, KIF2C shRNA Plasmid (m): sc-146476-SH, KIF2C shRNA (h) Lentiviral Particles: sc-105596-V and KIF2C shRNA (m) Lentiviral Particles: sc-146476-V.

# **RECOMMENDED SECONDARY REAGENTS**

To ensure optimal results, the following support (secondary) reagents are recommended: 1) Western Blotting: use donkey anti-goat IgG-HRP: sc-2020 (dilution range: 1:2000-1:100,000) or Cruz Marker™ compatible donkey anti-goat IgG-HRP: sc-2033 (dilution range: 1:2000-1:5000), Cruz Marker™ Molecular Weight Standards: sc-2035, TBS Blotto A Blocking Reagent: sc-2333 and Western Blotting Luminol Reagent: sc-2048. 2) Immunofluo-rescence: use donkey anti-goat IgG-TR: sc-2783 (dilution range: 1:100-1:400) with UltraCruz™ Mounting Medium: sc-24941.
