# FTHL19 (N-15): sc-323886



The Power to Question

### **BACKGROUND**

FTHL19 (ferritin heavy polypeptide 1 pseudogene 19), also known as FTH1P19, is a 201 amino acid protein that belongs to the ferritin family and contains one ferritin-like diiron domain. The gene encoding FTHL19 maps to human chromosome Xp22.33. The human X chromosome consists of about 153 million base pairs and nearly 1,000 genes. The combination of an X and Y chromosome lead to normal male development, while two copies of X lead to normal female development. There are a number of conditions related to an unusual number and combination of sex chromosomes being inherited, including Turner's syndrome, Klinefelter's syndrome and Triple X syndrome. Color blindness, hemophilia, and Duchenne muscular dystrophy are well-known X chromosome-linked conditions that affect males more frequently as males carry a single X chromosome.

FTHL19 (N-15) is an affinity purified goat polyclonal antibody raised against a peptide mapping at the N-terminus of FTHL19 of human origin.

#### **PRODUCT**

Each vial contains 200  $\mu g$  lgG in 1.0 ml of PBS with < 0.1% sodium azide and 0.1% gelatin.

### **APPLICATIONS**

FTHL19 (N-15) is recommended for detection of FTHL19 of human origin by Western Blotting (starting dilution 1:200, dilution range 1:100-1:1000), immunofluorescence (starting dilution 1:50, dilution range 1:50-1:500) and solid phase ELISA (starting dilution 1:30, dilution range 1:30-1:3000); non cross-reactive with FTHL17.

Suitable for use as control antibody for FTHL19 siRNA (h): sc-90896, FTHL19 shRNA Plasmid (h): sc-90896-SH and FTHL19 shRNA (h) Lentiviral Particles: sc-90896-V.

Molecular Weight of FTHL19: 23 kDa.
