The Power to Question

BACKGROUND

Zinc-finger proteins contain DNA-binding domains and have a wide variety of functions, most of which encompass some form of transcriptional activation or repression. The majority of zinc-finger proteins contain a Krüppel-type DNA binding domain and a KRAB domain, which is thought to interact with KAP1, thereby recruiting histone modifying proteins. ZNF184 (zinc finger protein 184) is a 751 amino acid nuclear protein implicated in transcriptional regulation. Expressed primarily in testis, ZNF184 is a member of the Krüppel $\rm C_2H_2$ -type zinc-finger protein family and contains one KRAB domain and 19 $\rm C_2H_2$ -type zinc fingers. The gene encoding ZNF184 maps to human chromosome 6, which contains 170 million base pairs and comprises nearly 6% of the human genome. Porphyria cutanea tarda, Parkinson's disease and Stickler syndrome are associated with defects in genes that map to chromosome 6.

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CHROMOSOMAL LOCATION

Genetic locus: ZNF184 (human) mapping to 6p22.1.

SOURCE

ZNF184 (W-18) is an affinity purified goat polyclonal antibody raised against a peptide mapping within an internal region of ZNF184 of human origin.

PRODUCT

Each vial contains 200 μg lgG in 1.0 ml of PBS with < 0.1% sodium azide and 0.1% gelatin.

Blocking peptide available for competition studies, sc-324539 P, (100 μ g peptide in 0.5 ml PBS containing < 0.1% sodium azide and 0.2% BSA).

APPLICATIONS

ZNF184 (W-18) is recommended for detection of ZNF184 of human origin by Western Blotting (starting dilution 1:200, dilution range 1:100-1:1000), immunofluorescence (starting dilution 1:50, dilution range 1:50-1:500) and solid phase ELISA (starting dilution 1:30, dilution range 1:30-1:3000); non cross-reactive with other zinc finger proteins.

Suitable for use as control antibody for ZNF184 siRNA (h): sc-95550, ZNF184 shRNA Plasmid (h): sc-95550-SH and ZNF184 shRNA (h) Lentiviral Particles: sc-95550-V.

Molecular Weight of ZNF184: 86 kDa.
