ZNF235 (I-17): sc-324557



The Power to Question

BACKGROUND

Zinc-finger proteins contain DNA-binding domains and have a wide variety of functions, most of which encompass some form of transcriptional activation or repression. The majority of zinc-finger proteins contain a Krüppel-type DNA binding domain and a KRAB domain, which is thought to interact with KAP1, thereby recruiting histone modifying proteins. As a member of the Krüppel C_2H_2 -type zinc-finger protein family, ZNF235 (zinc finger protein 235), also known as zinc finger protein 270 (ZNF270), zinc finger protein 93 homolog (Zfp-93) or zinc finger protein HZF6, is a 738 amino acid nuclear protein that contains 16 C_2H_2 -type zinc fingers and one KRAB domain. ZNF235 is a nuclear protein that is thought to be involved in transcriptional regulation.

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CHROMOSOMAL LOCATION

Genetic locus: ZNF235 (human) mapping to 19q13.31.

SOURCE

ZNF235 (I-17) is an affinity purified goat polyclonal antibody raised against a peptide mapping within an internal region of ZNF235 of human origin.

PRODUCT

Each vial contains 200 μg lgG in 1.0 ml of PBS with < 0.1% sodium azide and 0.1% gelatin.

Blocking peptide available for competition studies, sc-324557 P, (100 μ g peptide in 0.5 ml PBS containing < 0.1% sodium azide and 0.2% BSA).

STORAGE

Store at 4° C, **DO NOT FREEZE**. Stable for one year from the date of shipment. Non-hazardous. No MSDS required.

RESEARCH USE

For research use only, not for use in diagnostic procedures.

APPLICATIONS

ZNF235 (I-17) is recommended for detection of ZNF235 of human origin by Western Blotting (starting dilution 1:200, dilution range 1:100-1:1000), immunofluorescence (starting dilution 1:50, dilution range 1:50-1:500) and solid phase ELISA (starting dilution 1:30, dilution range 1:30-1:3000); non cross-reactive with other zinc finger proteins.

Suitable for use as control antibody for ZNF235 siRNA (h): sc-97244, ZNF235 shRNA Plasmid (h): sc-97244-SH and ZNF235 shRNA (h) Lentiviral Particles: sc-97244-V.
