ZNF404 (K-14): sc-324602



The Power to Question

BACKGROUND

ZNF404 (zinc finger protein 404), is a 552 amino acid nuclear protein that may be involved in transcriptional regulation. Belonging to the krüppel $\rm C_2H_2$ -type zinc-finger protein family, ZNF404 contains 15 $\rm C_2H_2$ -type zinc fingers and one KRAB domain. The gene that encodes ZNF404 consists of approximately 11,602 bases and maps to human chromosome 19q13.31. Chromosome 19 consists of over 63 million bases, houses approximately 1,400 genes and is recognized for having the greatest gene density of the human chromosomes. It is the genetic home for a number of immunoglobulin (Ig) superfamily members, including the killer cell and leukocyte Ig-like receptors, a number of ICAMs, the CEACAM and PSG families and Fc receptors (FcRs).

CHROMOSOMAL LOCATION

Genetic locus: ZNF404 (human) mapping to 19q13.31.

SOURCE

ZNF404 (K-14) is an affinity purified goat polyclonal antibody raised against a peptide mapping within an internal region of ZNF404 of human origin.

PRODUCT

Each vial contains 200 μg lgG in 1.0 ml of PBS with < 0.1% sodium azide and 0.1% gelatin.

Blocking peptide available for competition studies, sc-324602 P, (100 μ g peptide in 0.5 ml PBS containing < 0.1% sodium azide and 0.2% BSA).

APPLICATIONS

ZNF404 (K-14) is recommended for detection of ZNF404 of human origin by Western Blotting (starting dilution 1:200, dilution range 1:100-1:1000), immunofluorescence (starting dilution 1:50, dilution range 1:50-1:500) and solid phase ELISA (starting dilution 1:30, dilution range 1:30-1:3000); non cross-reactive with other zinc finger proteins.

Suitable for use as control antibody for ZNF404 siRNA (h): sc-97191, ZNF404 shRNA Plasmid (h): sc-97191-SH and ZNF404 shRNA (h) Lentiviral Particles: sc-97191-V.

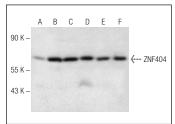

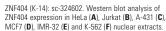

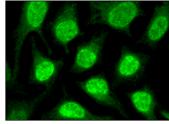
