ZNF566 (T-15): sc-324671



The Power to Question

BACKGROUND

ZNF566 (zinc finger protein 566) is a 418 amino acid nuclear protein that may be involved in transcriptional regulation. Belonging to the Krüppel C_2H_2 -type zinc-finger protein family, ZNF566 contains eight C_2H_2 -type zinc fingers and one KRAB domain. The gene that encodes ZNF566 is made up of approximately 44,784 bases and maps to human chromosome 19q13.12. Consisting of around 63 million bases with more than 1,400 genes, chromosome 19 makes up over 2% of the human genome. It is the genetic home for a number of immunoglobulin superfamily members including the killer cell and leukocyte lg-like receptors, a number of ICAMs, the CEACAM and PSG families, and Fc α receptors. Key genes for eye color and hair color also map to chromosome 19. Peutz-Jeghers syndrome, spinocerebellar ataxia type 6, the stroke disorder CADASIL, hypercholesterolemia and Insulin-dependent diabetes have been linked to chromosome 19.

Genetic locus: ZNF566 (human) mapping to 19g13.12.

ZNF566 (T-15) is an affinity purified goat polyclonal antibody raised against a peptide mapping within an internal region of ZNF566 of human origin.

APPLICATIONS

ZNF566 (T-15) is recommended for detection of ZNF566 of human origin by Western Blotting (starting dilution 1:200, dilution range 1:100-1:1000), immunofluorescence (starting dilution 1:50, dilution range 1:50-1:500) and solid phase ELISA (starting dilution 1:30, dilution range 1:30-1:3000); may cross-react with hnRNP E3.

Suitable for use as control antibody for ZNF566 siRNA (h): sc-97688, ZNF566 shRNA Plasmid (h): sc-97688-SH and ZNF566 shRNA (h) Lentiviral Particles: sc-97688-V.

Molecular Weight of ZNF566: 49 kDa.
