

# KIFC2 (C-17): sc-48572



BACKGROUND

The kinesin superfamily proteins (KIFs) are microtubule-dependent molecular motors that transport membranous organelles and protein complexes in a microtubule- and ATP-dependent manner. Cells use KIFs to tightly control the direction, destination, and speed of transportation of a variety of important functional molecules, including mRNA. KIFC2 is 792 amino acid member of the C-terminal motor family specifically expressed in both the central and peripheral nervous systems in nonproliferative cells. KIFC2 accumulates at the proximal and distal sides of axons and is a minus-end-directed kinesin. KIFC2 localizes with some, but not all, axonally transported organelles. KIFC2 may be involved in retrograde axonal transport.

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# CHROMOSOMAL LOCATION

Genetic locus: KIFC2 (human) mapping to 8q24.3; Kifc2 (mouse) mapping to 15 D-E.

## SOURCE

KIFC2 (C-17) is an affinity purified goat polyclonal antibody raised against a peptide mapping within an internal region of KIFC2 of human origin.

## PRODUCT

Each vial contains 200  $\mu g$  lgG in 1.0 ml of PBS with < 0.1% sodium azide and 0.1% gelatin.

Blocking peptide available for competition studies, sc-48572 P, (100  $\mu$ g peptide in 0.5 ml PBS containing < 0.1% sodium azide and 0.2% BSA).

#### **APPLICATIONS**

KIFC2 (C-17) is recommended for detection of KIFC2 of mouse, rat and human origin by Western Blotting (starting dilution 1:200, dilution range 1:100-1:1000), immunofluorescence (starting dilution 1:50, dilution range 1:50-1:500) and solid phase ELISA (starting dilution 1:30, dilution range 1:30-1:3000).

Suitable for use as control antibody for KIFC2 siRNA (h): sc-60890 and KIFC2 siRNA (m): sc-60891.

Molecular Weight of KIFC2: 90 kDa.

#### **RECOMMENDED SECONDARY REAGENTS**

To ensure optimal results, the following support (secondary) reagents are recommended: 1) Western Blotting: use donkey anti-goat IgG-HRP: sc-2020 (dilution range: 1:2000-1:100,000) or Cruz Marker<sup>™</sup> compatible donkey anti-goat IgG-HRP: sc-2033 (dilution range: 1:2000-1:5000), Cruz Marker<sup>™</sup> Molecular Weight Standards: sc-2035, TBS Blotto A Blocking Reagent: sc-2333 and Western Blotting Luminol Reagent: sc-2048. 2) Immunofluo-rescence: use donkey anti-goat IgG-TR: sc-2783 (dilution range: 1:100-1:400) with UltraCruz<sup>™</sup> Mounting Medium: sc-24941.

Store at 4° C, \*\*D0 NOT FREEZE\*\*. Stable for one year from the date of shipment. Non-hazardous. No MSDS required.
