PRDM5 (C-12): sc-48653



The Power to Question

BACKGROUND

A cDNA of PRDM5 was isolated based upon its homology to the PR domain of PRDM2. The gene encodes an open reading frame of 630 amino acids and contains a PR domain in the NH-terminal region followed by 16 zinc finger motifs. Through radiation hybrid analysis, PRDM5 was mapped to human chromosome 4q27, a region thought to contain tumor suppressor genes for ovarian, breast, lung, liver, colon and other cancers. The gene has a CpG island promoter and is silenced in human breast, ovarian and liver cancers. Upon infection of tumor cells, a recombinant adenovirus expressing PRDM5 causes $\rm G_2/M$ arrest and apoptosis, suggesting that inhibition of PRDM5 may be involved in carcinogenesis.

CHROMOSOMAL LOCATION

Genetic locus: PRDM5 (human) mapping to 4q27; Prdm5 (mouse) mapping to 6 C1.

SOURCE

PRDM5 (C-12) is an affinity purified goat polyclonal antibody raised against a peptide mapping near the C-terminus of PRDM5 of human origin.

PRODUCT

Each vial contains 200 μg lgG in 1.0 ml of PBS with < 0.1% sodium azide and 0.1% gelatin.

Blocking peptide available for competition studies, sc-48653 P, (100 μ g peptide in 0.5 ml PBS containing < 0.1% sodium azide and 0.2% BSA).

Available as TransCruz reagent for Gel Supershift and ChIP applications, sc-48653 X, 200 $\mu g/0.1$ ml.

APPLICATIONS

PRDM5 (C-12) is recommended for detection of PRDM5 of mouse and human origin by Western Blotting (starting dilution 1:200, dilution range 1:100-1:1000), immunoprecipitation [1-2 μ g per 100-500 μ g of total protein (1 ml of cell lysate)], immunofluorescence (starting dilution 1:50, dilution range 1:50-1:500), immunohistochemistry (including paraffin-embedded sections) (starting dilution 1:50, dilution range 1:50-1:500) and solid phase ELISA (starting dilution 1:30, dilution range 1:30-1:3000).

PRDM5 (C-12) is also recommended for detection of PRDM5 in additional species, including equine, canine, bovine and porcine.

Suitable for use as control antibody for PRDM5 siRNA (h): sc-61397, PRDM5 siRNA (m): sc-61398, PRDM5 shRNA Plasmid (h): sc-61397-SH, PRDM5 shRNA Plasmid (m): sc-61398-SH, PRDM5 shRNA (h) Lentiviral Particles: sc-61397-V and PRDM5 shRNA (m) Lentiviral Particles: sc-61398-V.


