The Power to Question

BACKGROUND

The SLC20 family transport proteins were originally identified as retroviral receptors Glvr-1 and Ram-1, but are now designated sodium-dependent phosphate transporters 1 and 2 (PiT1 and PiT2). The PiT proteins function as sodium-phosphate cotransporters and are widely expressed, with high expression in bone, kidney and intestine. Both PiT1 and PiT2 are expressed on polarized epithelial cell membranes where they play a role in cellular phosphate homeostasis. PiT2 is a human receptor for amphotropic murine leukemia virus (A-MuLV). A-MuLV infects a variety of mammalian cell lines, including humans, making it a useful tool in gene transfer technology and as a vector for gene therapy. Retroviral vector systems are used in gene therapy that are designed to infect cells expressing PiT1 or PiT2.

CHROMOSOMAL LOCATION

Genetic locus: SLC20A1 (human) mapping to 2q13, SLC20A2 (human) mapping to 8p11.21; Slc20a1 (mouse) mapping to 2 F1, Slc20a2 (mouse) mapping to 8 A2.

SOURCE

PiT1/2 (C-20) is an affinity purified goat polyclonal antibody raised against a peptide mapping near the C-terminus of PiT2 of human origin.

PRODUCT

Each vial contains 200 μg IgG in 1.0 ml of PBS with <0.1% sodium azide and 0.1% gelatin.

Blocking peptide available for competition studies, sc-50271 P, (100 μ g peptide in 0.5 ml PBS containing < 0.1% sodium azide and 0.2% BSA).

APPLICATIONS

PiT1/2 (C-20) is recommended for detection of PiT1 and PiT2 of mouse, rat and human origin by Western Blotting (starting dilution 1:200, dilution range 1:100-1:1000), immunofluorescence (starting dilution 1:50, dilution range 1:50-1:500) and solid phase ELISA (starting dilution 1:30, dilution range 1:30-1:3000); may cross-react with NCOA2 in human.

PiT1/2 (C-20) is also recommended for detection of PiT1 and PiT2 in additional species, including equine, canine, bovine and porcine.

Molecular Weight of PiT1/2: 70 kDa.

Positive Controls: HeLa whole cell lysate: sc-2200.
