The Power to Ouestion

BACKGROUND

Myosin is a highly conserved, ubiquitously expressed protein that interacts with Actin to generate the force for cellular movements. Conventional Myosins are hexameric proteins consisting of two heavy chain subunits, a pair of nonphosphorylatable light chain subunits and a pair of phosphorylatable light chain subunits. Three general classes of Myosin have been cloned: smooth muscle Myosins (such as MYH11), striated muscle Myosins and nonmuscle Myosins. Contractile activity in smooth muscle is regulated by the calcium/calmodulin-dependent phosphorylation of Myosin light chain (MLC) by Myosin light chain kinase. Myosin heavy chains, encoded by the MYH gene family, contain Actin-activated ATPase activity which generates the motor function of Myosin. Myosin heavy chains were initially isolated from a human fetal skeletal muscle and are the major determinant in the speed of contraction of skeletal muscle. Various isoforms of Myosin heavy chains are differentially expressed depending on the functional activity of the muscle.

CHROMOSOMAL LOCATION

Genetic locus: MYH11 (human) mapping to 16p13.11; Myh11 (mouse) mapping to 16 A1.

SOURCE

MYH11 (ID8) is a mouse monoclonal antibody raised against crude smooth muscle extract from uterus myometrium of human origin.

PRODUCT

Each vial contains 200 $\mu g \ lgG_1$ kappa light chain in 1.0 ml of PBS with < 0.1% sodium azide and 0.1% gelatin.

STORAGE

Store at 4° C, **DO NOT FREEZE**. Stable for one year from the date of shipment. Non-hazardous. No MSDS required.

APPLICATIONS

MYH11 (ID8) is recommended for detection of myosin heavy chain 11 isoforms SM-1 and SM-2 of mouse, rat and human origin by Western Blotting (starting dilution 1:200, dilution range 1:100-1:1000), immunoprecipitation [1-2 μ g per 100-500 μ g of total protein (1 ml of cell lysate)], immunofluorescence (starting dilution 1:50, dilution range 1:50-1:500) and immunohistochemistry (including paraffin-embedded sections) (starting dilution 1:50, dilution range 1:50-1:500).

Suitable for use as control antibody for MYH11 siRNA (h): sc-76523, MYH11 siRNA (m): sc-76524, MYH11 shRNA Plasmid (h): sc-76523-SH, MYH11 shRNA Plasmid (m): sc-76524-SH, MYH11 shRNA (h) Lentiviral Particles: sc-76523-V and MYH11 shRNA (m) Lentiviral Particles: sc-76524-V.




