The Power to Question

BACKGROUND

Members of the oxyserol-binding protein (OSBP) family function as intracellular lipid receptors. OSBPs are involved in lipid metabolism and signal transduction, as well as vesicle transport, and can translocate to the periphery of Golgi membranes when they are bound to oxysterols. ORPs (OSBP-related proteins) belong to a subfamily of OSBPs and consist of ORP-1 and ORP-2. The ORPs have a highly conserved OSBP-type sterol-binding region and a Pleckstrin homology domain. They strongly bind to phosphatidic acid and weakly bind to phosphatidylinositol 3-phosphate. Two isoforms of ORP-2 are produced due to alternative splicing. ORP-2 is expressed only in retina, retinal pigment epithelium choroid, pineal gland and cultured retinal pigment epithelial cells. Overexpression of ORP-2 decreases cell growth and blocks Golgi-derived vesicle transport.

ORP-2 (M-15) is an affinity purified goat polyclonal antibody raised against a peptide mapping at the C-terminus of ORP-2 of mouse origin.

Blocking peptide available for competition studies, sc-66570 P, (100 μ g peptide in 0.5 ml PBS containing < 0.1% sodium azide and 0.2% BSA).

APPLICATIONS

ORP-2 (M-15) is recommended for detection of Oxysterol-binding protein-related protein 2 of mouse and rat origin by Western Blotting (starting dilution 1:200, dilution range 1:100-1:1000), immunofluorescence (starting dilution 1:50, dilution range 1:50-1:500) and solid phase ELISA (starting dilution 1:30, dilution range 1:30-1:3000).

Suitable for use as control antibody for ORP-2 siRNA (m): sc-62718.
