# Swi6 (yN-19): sc-6734



The Power to Question

#### **BACKGROUND**

Commitment to cell division occurs at a point late in the G1 phase of the cell cycle, termed Start. Passage through Start requires the activation of the Cdc28 protein kinase by the cell cycle-regulated G1 cyclins. Maximal expression of these G1 cyclins is induced by the heterodimeric transcription factor complex composed of Swi4 (also designated Art1) and Swi6. Swi4 is the DNA-binding subunit of this complex. In addition to binding Swi4, Swi6 forms a complex with Mbp1. This complex activates S-phase cyclins and genes involved in DNA synthesis.
