# FAM84B (N-20): sc-74754



The Power to Question

## **BACKGROUND**

FAM84B (family with sequence similarity 84, member B), also known as NSE2 or BCMP101, is a 310 amino acid protein that is expressed in esophageal squamous cell carcinomas, suggesting a role in tumor development and metastasis. The gene encoding FAM84B maps to human chromosome 8, which consists of nearly 146 million base pairs, houses more than 800 genes and is associated with a variety of diseases and malignancies. Schizophrenia, bipolar disorder, trisomy 8, Pfeiffer syndrome, congenital hypothyroidism, Waardenburg syndrome and some leukemias and lymphomas are thought to occur as a result of defects in specific genes that map to chromosome 8.

## CHROMOSOMAL LOCATION

Genetic locus: FAM84B (human) mapping to 8q24.21; Fam84b (mouse) mapping to 15 D1.

## SOURCE

FAM84B (N-20) is an affinity purified goat polyclonal antibody raised against a peptide mapping near the N-terminus of FAM84B of human origin.

## **STORAGE**

Store at 4° C, \*\*D0 NOT FREEZE\*\*. Stable for one year from the date of shipment. Non-hazardous. No MSDS required.

#### **PRODUCT**

Each vial contains 200  $\mu g$  IgG in 1.0 ml of PBS with <0.1% sodium azide and 0.1% gelatin.

Blocking peptide available for competition studies, sc-74754 P, (100  $\mu$ g peptide in 0.5 ml PBS containing < 0.1% sodium azide and 0.2% BSA).

## **APPLICATIONS**

FAM84B (N-20) is recommended for detection of FAM84B of mouse, rat and human origin by Western Blotting (starting dilution 1:200, dilution range 1:100-1:1000), immunofluorescence (starting dilution 1:50, dilution range 1:50-1:500) and solid phase ELISA (starting dilution 1:30, dilution range 1:30-1:3000).

FAM84B (N-20) is also recommended for detection of FAM84B in additional species, including equine, bovine, porcine and avian.

Suitable for use as control antibody for FAM84B siRNA (h): sc-75960, FAM84B shRNA Plasmid (h): sc-75960-SH and FAM84B shRNA (h) Lentiviral Particles: sc-75960-V.

Molecular Weight of FAM84B: 34 kDa.
