# LSm3 (T-15): sc-74954



The Power to Question

#### **BACKGROUND**

Sm and Sm-like (LSm) proteins form donut shaped heptameric complexes that are involved in various steps of RNA metabolism. Lsm proteins facilitate RNA protein interactions and structural changes that are required during ribosomal subunit assembly. LSm3 (U6 snRNA-associated Sm-like protein LSm3) is a 102 amino acid nuclear protein that specifically binds the 3'-terminal U-tract of U6 snRNA. The homomeric LSm3 octamer recruits LSm6, LSm2 and LSm5 to facilitate the formation of U4/U6 RNA duplices. The gene encoding LSm3 maps to human chromosome 3, which is made up of about 214 million bases encoding over 1,100 genes, including a chemokine receptor (CKR) gene cluster and a variety of human cancer-related gene loci. Marfan Syndrome, porphyria, von Hippel-Lindau syndrome, osteogenesis imperfecta and Charcot-Marie-Tooth Disease are a few of the numerous genetic diseases associated with chromosome 3.

Genetic locus: LSM3 (human) mapping to 3p25.1; Lsm3 (mouse) mapping to 6 D1.

#### **SOURCE**

LSm3 (T-15) is an affinity purified goat polyclonal antibody raised against a peptide mapping near the N-terminus of LSm3 of human origin.

#### **PRODUCT**

Each vial contains 200  $\mu g$  IgG in 1.0 ml of PBS with <0.1% sodium azide and 0.1% gelatin.

Blocking peptide available for competition studies, sc-74954 P, (100  $\mu$ g peptide in 0.5 ml PBS containing < 0.1% sodium azide and 0.2% BSA).

Available as TransCruz reagent for Gel Supershift and ChIP applications, sc-74954 X, 200  $\mu g/0.1$  ml.

#### **APPLICATIONS**

LSm3 (T-15) is recommended for detection of LSm3 of mouse, rat and human origin by Western Blotting (starting dilution 1:200, dilution range 1:100-1:1000), immunofluorescence (starting dilution 1:50, dilution range 1:50-1:500) and solid phase ELISA (starting dilution 1:30, dilution range 1:30-1:3000).

LSm3 (T-15) is also recommended for detection of LSm3 in additional species, including equine, canine, bovine, porcine and avian.

Suitable for use as control antibody for LSm3 siRNA (h): sc-75707, LSm3 siRNA (m): sc-75708, LSm3 shRNA Plasmid (h): sc-75707-SH, LSm3 shRNA Plasmid (m): sc-75708-SH, LSm3 shRNA (h) Lentiviral Particles: sc-75707-V and LSm3 shRNA (m) Lentiviral Particles: sc-75708-V.
