The Power to Question

BACKGROUND

Fibulin proteins contribute to normal development of elastic fiber systems in various types of organs that require elasticity, such as vasculature, lung and skin. Fibulin-4, also known as EFEMP2 (EGF-containing fibulin-like extracellular matrix protein 2), MBP1 or UPH1 is a 443 amino acid secreted protein that contains 6 EGF-like calcium-binding domains and belongs to the Fibulin family. Expressed ubiquitously with highest expression in heart, Fibulin-4 is essential for connective tissue development and elastic fiber formation, and may also play an important role in vascular patterning and collagen biosynthesis. Defects in the gene encoding Fibulin-4 are associated with autosomal recessive cutis laxa type I (CL type I), a connective tissue disorder that is inherited in both an autosomal dominant and an autosomal recessive manner and is characterized by inelastic tissue in all affected areas of the body.

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CHROMOSOMAL LOCATION

Genetic locus: EFEMP2 (human) mapping to 11q13.1; Efemp2 (mouse) mapping to 19 A.

SOURCE

Fibulin-4 (E-19) is an affinity purified goat polyclonal antibody raised against a peptide mapping within an internal region of Fibulin-4 of human origin.

PRODUCT

Each vial contains 200 μg IgG in 1.0 ml of PBS with <0.1% sodium azide and 0.1% gelatin.

Blocking peptide available for competition studies, sc-79240 P, (100 μg peptide in 0.5 ml PBS containing < 0.1% sodium azide and 0.2% BSA).

APPLICATIONS

Fibulin-4 (E-19) is recommended for detection of Fibulin-4 of mouse, rat and human origin by Western Blotting (starting dilution 1:200, dilution range 1:100-1:1000), immunofluorescence (starting dilution 1:50, dilution range 1:50-1:500) and solid phase ELISA (starting dilution 1:30, dilution range 1:30-1:3000).

Fibulin-4 (E-19) is also recommended for detection of Fibulin-4 in additional species, including equine, canine, bovine and porcine.
