## BACKGROUND

AS250 (250 kDa substrate of Akt) is a 1,873 amino acid protein encoded by a gene which maps to human chromosome 20. Representing about 2\% of human DNA, chromosome 20 consists of approximately 63 million bases and 600 genes. Chromosome 20 contains a region with numerous genes expressed in the epididymis which are thought important for seminal production and some are viewed as potential targets for male contraception. The PRNP gene encoding the prion protein associated with spongiform encephalopathies, like Creutzfeldt-Jakob disease, is found on chromosome 20. Amyotrophic lateral sclerosis, spinal muscular atrophy, ring chromosome 20 epilepsy syndrome and Alagille syndrome are also associated with chromosome 20.

## SOURCE

AS250 (T-14) is an affinity purified rabbit polyclonal antibody raised against a peptide mapping within an internal region of AS250 of human origin.

## PRODUCT

Each vial contains $100 \mu \mathrm{gg} \lg$ in 1.0 ml of PBS with < $0.1 \%$ sodium azide and $0.1 \%$ gelatin.

## STORAGE

## APPLICATIONS

AS250 (T-14) is recommended for detection of AS250 of mouse, rat and human origin by Western Blotting (starting dilution 1:200, dilution range 1:100-1:1000), immunofluorescence (starting dilution 1:50, dilution range 1:50-1:500) and solid phase ELISA (starting dilution 1:30, dilution range 1:30-1:3000).
