C20orf72 (K-20): sc-85434



The Power to Question

BACKGROUND

Representing about 2% of human DNA, chromosome 20 consists of approximately 63 million bases and 600 genes. Chromosome 20 contains a region with numerous genes expressed in the epididymis, which are thought important for seminal production, and some viewed as potential targets for male contraception. The PRNP gene encoding the prion protein associated with spongiform encephalopathies, like Creutzfeldt-Jakob disease, is found on chromosome 20. Amyotrophic lateral sclerosis, spinal muscular atrophy, ring chromosome 20 epilepsy syndrome and Alagille syndrome are also associated with chromosome 20. The C20orf72 gene product has been provisionally designated C20orf72 pending further characterization.

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CHROMOSOMAL LOCATION

Genetic locus: C20orf72 (human) mapping to 20p11.23.

SOURCE

C20orf72 (K-20) is an affinity purified rabbit polyclonal antibody raised against a peptide mapping within an internal region of C20orf72 of human origin.

STORAGE

Store at 4° C, **DO NOT FREEZE**. Stable for one year from the date of shipment. Non-hazardous. No MSDS required.

PRODUCT

Each vial contains 100 μg IgG in 1.0 ml of PBS with <0.1% sodium azide and 0.1% gelatin.

Blocking peptide available for competition studies, sc-85434 P, (100 μ g peptide in 0.5 ml PBS containing < 0.1% sodium azide and 0.2% BSA).

APPLICATIONS

C20orf72 (K-20) is recommended for detection of C20orf72 of human origin by Western Blotting (starting dilution 1:200, dilution range 1:100-1:1000), immunofluorescence (starting dilution 1:50, dilution range 1:50-1:500) and solid phase ELISA (starting dilution 1:30, dilution range 1:30-1:3000).

C20orf72 (K-20) is also recommended for detection of C20orf72 in additional species, including equine and bovine.

Suitable for use as control antibody for C20orf72 siRNA (h): sc-72743, C20orf72 shRNA Plasmid (h): sc-72743-SH and C20orf72 shRNA (h) Lentiviral Particles: sc-72743-V.

Molecular Weight of C20orf72: 39 kDa.
