

LOC198437 (A-19): sc-85611

BACKGROUND

LOC198437 is a 194 amino acid protein that exists as two alternatively spliced isoforms and is encoded by a gene located on human chromosome 20q13.33. Representing about 2% of human DNA, chromosome 20 consists of approximately 63 million bases and 600 genes. Chromosome 20 contains a region with numerous genes expressed in the epididymis which are thought important for seminal production and some viewed as potential targets for male contraception. The PRNP gene encoding the prion protein associated with spongiform encephalopathies, like Creutzfeldt-Jakob disease, is found on chromosome 20. Amyotrophic lateral sclerosis, spinal muscular atrophy, ring chromosome 20 epilepsy syndrome and Alagille syndrome are also associated with chromosome 20. The LOC198437 gene product has been provisionally designated LOC198437 pending further characterization.

LOC198437 (A-19) is an affinity purified rabbit polyclonal antibody raised against a peptide mapping within an internal region of LOC198437 of human origin.

STORAGE

Store at 4° C, ****DO NOT FREEZE****. Stable for one year from the date of shipment. Non-hazardous. No MSDS required.

PRODUCT

Each vial contains 100 µg IgG in 1.0 ml of PBS with < 0.1% sodium azide and 0.1% gelatin.

Blocking peptide available for competition studies, sc-85611 P, (100 µg peptide in 0.5 ml PBS containing < 0.1% sodium azide and 0.2% BSA).

APPLICATIONS

LOC198437 (A-19) is recommended for detection of LOC198437 of human origin by Western Blotting (starting dilution 1:200, dilution range 1:100-1:1000), immunofluorescence (starting dilution 1:50, dilution range 1:50-1:500) and solid phase ELISA (starting dilution 1:30, dilution range 1:30-1:3000).

Suitable for use as control antibody for LOC198437 siRNA (h): sc-75446, LOC198437 shRNA Plasmid (h): sc-75446-SH and LOC198437 shRNA (h) Lentiviral Particles: sc-75446-V.

Molecular Weight of LOC198437 isoforms: 22/26 kDa.

RECOMMENDED SECONDARY REAGENTS
