The Power to Question

BACKGROUND

Chromosome 22 contains over 500 genes and about 49 million bases. Being the second smallest human chromosome, 22 contains a surprising variety of interesting genes. Phelan-McDermid syndrome, Neurofibromatosis type 2 and autism are associated with chromosome 22. A schizophrenia susceptibility locus has been identified on chromosome 22 and studies show that 22q11 deletion symptoms include a high incidence of schizophrenia. Translocations between chromosomes 9 and 22 may lead to the formation of the Philadelphia Chromosome and the subsequent production of the novel fusion protein, Bcr-Abl, a potent cell proliferation activator found in several types of leukemia. The LOC388910 gene product has been provisionally designated LOC388910 pending further characterization.

LOC388910 (C-13) is an affinity purified rabbit polyclonal antibody raised against a peptide mapping within an internal region of LOC388910 of human origin.

APPLICATIONS

LOC388910 (C-13) is recommended for detection of LOC388910 of human origin by Western Blotting (starting dilution 1:200, dilution range 1:100-1:1000), immunofluorescence (starting dilution 1:50, dilution range 1:50-1:500) and solid phase ELISA (starting dilution 1:30, dilution range 1:30-1:3000).

Suitable for use as control antibody for LOC388910 siRNA (h): sc-75476, LOC388910 shRNA Plasmid (h): sc-75476-SH and LOC388910 shRNA (h) Lentiviral Particles: sc-75476-V.
