TMEM65 (S-13): sc-87464



The Power to Question

BACKGROUND

TMEM65 (transmembrane protein 65) is a 240 amino acid protein encoded by a gene mapping to human chromosome 8. Made up of nearly 146 million bases, chromosome 8 encodes about 800 genes. Translocation of portions of chromosome 8 with amplifications of the c-Myc gene are found in some leukemias and lymphomas, and typically associated with a poor prognosis. Portions of chromosome 8 have been linked to schizophrenia and bipolar disorder. Trisomy 8, also known as Warkany syndrome 2, most often results in early miscarriage but is occasionally seen in a mosaic form in surviving patients who suffer to a varying degree from a number of symptoms including retarded mental and motor development, and certain facial and developmental defects. WRN is a DNA helicase encoded by chromosome 8 and shown defective in those with the early aging disorder Werner syndrome. Chromosome 8 is also associated with Pfeiffer syndrome, congenital hypothyroidism and Waardenburg syndrome.

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CHROMOSOMAL LOCATION

Genetic locus: TMEM65 (human) mapping to 8q24.13; Tmem65 (mouse) mapping to 15 D1.

SOURCE

TMEM65 (S-13) is an affinity purified rabbit polyclonal antibody raised against a peptide mapping within an internal region of TMEM65 of human origin.

PRODUCT

Each vial contains 100 μg lgG in 1.0 ml of PBS with < 0.1% sodium azide and 0.1% gelatin.

Blocking peptide available for competition studies, sc-87464 P, (100 μ g peptide in 0.5 ml PBS containing < 0.1% sodium azide and 0.2% BSA).

APPLICATIONS

TMEM65 (S-13) is recommended for detection of TMEM65 of mouse, rat and human origin by Western Blotting (starting dilution 1:200, dilution range 1:100-1:1000), immunofluorescence (starting dilution 1:50, dilution range 1:50-1:500) and solid phase ELISA (starting dilution 1:30, dilution range 1:30-1:3000); non cross-reactive with other TMEM family members.

TMEM65 (S-13) is also recommended for detection of TMEM65 in additional species, including equine, canine and avian.
