# GATAD2A (h): 293 Lysate: sc-113052



The Power to Question

#### **BACKGROUND**

GATAD2A (GATA zinc finger domain containing 2A), also known as p66 $\alpha$ , is a ubiquitously expressed, highly conserved protein that is essential for development. GATAD2A contains a GATA-type zinc finger and is a component of the NuRD (nucleosome remodeling and histone deacetylation) complex along with MBD2, HDAC1 and HDAC2. The NuRD complex is associated with ATP-dependent chromatin-remodeling and histone deacetylase activity. GATAD2A interacts with MBD2 and MBD3 and colocalizes with MBD2 in nuclear speckles. This interaction enhances repression mediated by MBD2 and allows for the interaction with histone tails. GATAD2A contains two domains involved in transcriptional repression. For functional repressor activity, GATAD2A requires SUMOylation at Lys-30 and Lys-487.

### **STORAGE**

Store at -20° C. Repeated freezing and thawing should be minimized. Sample vial should be boiled once prior to use. Non-hazardous. No MSDS required.

GATAD2A (h): 293 Lysate is suitable as a Western Blotting positive control for human reactive GATAD2A antibodies. Recommended use: 10-20  $\mu$ l per lane

Control 293 Lysate: sc-110760 is available as a Western Blotting negative control lysate derived from non-transfected 293 cells.
