# E2F-1 (m): 293T Lysate: sc-126755



The Power to Question

## **BACKGROUND**

The human retinoblastoma gene product plays an important role in the negative regulation of cell proliferation. Functional inactivation of Rb can be mediated either through mutation or as a consequence of interaction with DNA tumor virus encoded proteins. Of all the Rb associations described to date, the identification of a complex between Rb and the transcription factor E2F most directly implicates Rb in regulation of cell proliferation. E2F was originally identified through its role in transcriptional activation of the Adenovirus E2 promoter. Sequences that are homologous to the E2F binding site exist upstream of a number of genes that encode proteins with putative functions in the  $\rm G_1/S$  phases of the cell cycle. E2F-1 is a member of a broader family of transcription regulators including E2F-2, E2F-3, E2F-4, E2F-5 and E2F-6, each of which forms heterodimers with a second protein, DP-1, forming an "active" E2F transcriptional regulatory complex.

# **STORAGE**

Store at -20° C. Repeated freezing and thawing should be minimized. Sample vial should be boiled once prior to use. Non-hazardous. No MSDS required.

### **PRODUCT**

E2F-1 (m): 293T Lysate represents a lysate of mouse E2F-1 transfected 293T cells and is provided as 100 µg protein in 200 µl SDS-PAGE buffer.

#### **APPLICATIONS**

E2F-1 (m): 293T Lysate is suitable as a Western Blotting positive control for mouse reactive E2F-1 antibodies. Recommended use: 10-20 µl per lane.


Control 293T Lysate: sc-117752 is available as a Western Blotting negative control lysate derived from non-transfected 293T cells.

E2F-1 (KH129): sc-56661 is recommended as a positive control antibody for Western Blot analysis of enhanced mouse E2F-1 expression in E2F-1 transfected 293T cells (starting dilution 1:100, dilution range 1:100-1:1,000).
