GABA_B R2 (h3): 293T Lysate: sc-158538



The Power to Question

BACKGROUND

GAD-65 and GAD-67, glutamate decarboxylases function to catalyze the production of GABA (γ -aminobutyric acid). In the central nervous system GABA functions as the main inhibitory transmitter by increasing a Cl-conductance that inhibits neuronal firing. GABA has been shown to activate both ionotropic (GABA_A) and metabotropic (GABA_B) receptors as well as a third class of receptors called GABA_C. Both GABA_A and GABA_C are ligand-gated ion channels, however, they are structurally and functionally distinct. Members of the GABA_A receptor family include GABA_A Ra1-6, GABA_A R β 1-3, GABA_A R γ 1-3, GABA_A R δ , GABA_A R ϵ , GABA_A R ϵ 1 and GABA_B R1 ϵ 2. The GABA_B family is composed of GABA_B R1 ϵ 3 and GABA_B R1 ϵ 5. GABA transporters have also been identified and include GABA transporters function to terminate GABA action.

GABA $_B$ R2 (h3): 293T Lysate is suitable as a Western Blotting positive control for human reactive GABA $_B$ R2 antibodies. Recommended use: 10-20 μ l per lane.

Control 293T Lysate: sc-117752 is available as a Western Blotting negative control lysate derived from non-transfected 293T cells.

STORAGE

Store at -20° C. Repeated freezing and thawing should be minimized. Sample vial should be boiled once prior to use. Non-hazardous. No MSDS required.
