Health Hazards (Acute and Chronic):

To the best of our knowledge, the chemical, physical, and toxicological properties have not been thoroughly investigated. Trilostane produces suppression of the adrenal cortex by inhibiting enzymatic conversion of steroids by 3-beta-hydroxysteroid dehydrogenase/delta 5,4 ketosteroid isomerase, thus blocking synthesis of adrenal steroids. CarcinogenicityStudies for 18 months in rats given doses of 250 mg per kg of body weight (mg/kg) per day found an increased incidence of adrenal adenomas. These were shown to be related to compensatory adrenocorticotropic hormone (ACTH) stimulation rather than to a direct action of trilostane. MutagenicityStandard tests found no evidence of mutagenicity. Pregnancy/ReproductionFertility Gonadal function may be depressed during trilostane therapy. This is reversible upon cessation of therapy. Pregnancy Trilostane is not recommended during pregnancy because it has been reported to reduce circulating progesterone, produce cervical dilation, and terminate pregnancy in some women. Studies in rats have shown that trilostane is teratogenic (skeletal abnormalities) in doses approximately 13 times the recommended human dose; teratogenicity seems to be related to the reduction in circulating progesterone.
