PI 3-kinase p110δ siRNA (m): sc-39132



The Power to Question

BACKGROUND

Phosphatidylinositol 3-kinase (PI 3-kinase) is composed of p85 and p110 subunits. p85 lacks PI 3-kinase activity and acts as an adapter, coupling p110 to activated protein tyrosine kinase. Two forms of p85 have been described (p85 α and p85 β), each possessing one SH3 and two SH2 domains. Various p110 forms have been identified. p110 α and p110 β interact with p85 α , and p110 α has also been shown to interact with p85 β in vitro. It has been shown to bind p85 α and β , but it apparently does not phosphorylate these subunits. p110 δ has the capacity to autophosphorylate and results in the nearly complete inactivation of the lipid kinase activity. Interestingly, p110 γ does not interact with the p85 subunits and has been shown to be activated by α and $\beta\gamma$ heterotrimeric G proteins. Two p110 δ isoforms have been identified and are widely expressed. Isoform 1 is expressed predominantly in leukocytes while isoform 2 is expressed in normal thymus, lung and spleen tissues.

CHROMOSOMAL LOCATION

Genetic locus: Pik3cd (mouse) mapping to 4 E2.

PRODUCT

Pl 3-kinase p110 δ siRNA (m) is a pool of 3 target-specific 19-25 nt siRNAs designed to knock down gene expression. Each vial contains 3.3 nmol of lyophilized siRNA, sufficient for a 10 μ M solution once resuspended using protocol below. Suitable for 50-100 transfections. Also see Pl 3-kinase p110 δ shRNA Plasmid (m): sc-39132-SH and Pl 3-kinase p110 δ shRNA (m) Lentiviral Particles: sc-39132-V as alternate gene silencing products.

For independent verification of PI 3-kinase p1108 (m) gene silencing results, we also provide the individual siRNA duplex components. Each is available as 3.3 nmol of lyophilized siRNA. These include: sc-39132A, sc-39132B and sc-39132C.

STORAGE AND RESUSPENSION

Store lyophilized siRNA duplex at -20° C with desiccant. Stable for at least one year from the date of shipment. Once resuspended, store at -20° C, avoid contact with RNAses and repeated freeze thaw cycles.

Resuspend lyophilized siRNA duplex in 330 μ l of the RNAse-free water provided. Resuspension of the siRNA duplex in 330 μ l of RNAse-free water makes a 10 μ M solution in a 10 μ M Tris-HCl, pH 8.0, 20 mM NaCl, 1 mM EDTA buffered solution.

APPLICATIONS

PI 3-kinase p110 δ siRNA (m) is recommended for the inhibition of PI 3-kinase p110 δ expression in mouse cells.

SUPPORT REAGENTS

For optimal siRNA transfection efficiency, Santa Cruz Biotechnology's siRNA Transfection Reagent: sc-29528 (0.3 ml), siRNA Transfection Medium: sc-36868 (20 ml) and siRNA Dilution Buffer: sc-29527 (1.5 ml) are recommended. Control siRNAs or Fluorescein Conjugated Control siRNAs are available as 10 µM in 66 µl. Each contain a scrambled sequence that will not lead to the specific degradation of any known cellular mRNA. Fluorescein Conjugated Control siRNAs include: sc-36869, sc-44239, sc-44240 and sc-44241. Control siRNAs include: sc-37007, sc-44230, sc-44231, sc-44232, sc-44233, sc-44234, sc-44235, sc-44236, sc-44237 and sc-44238.

GENE EXPRESSION MONITORING

Pl 3-kinase p110 δ (A-8): sc-55589 is recommended as a control antibody for monitoring of Pl 3-kinase p110 δ gene expression knockdown by Western Blotting (starting dilution 1:200, dilution range 1:100-1:1000) or immunofluorescence (starting dilution 1:50, dilution range 1:50-1:500).

To ensure optimal results, the following support reagents are recommended: 1) Western Blotting: use m-lgG κ BP-HRP: sc-516102 or m-lgG κ BP-HRP (Cruz Marker): sc-516102-CM (dilution range: 1:1000-1:10000), Cruz MarkerTM Molecular Weight Standards: sc-2035, UltraCruz[®] Blocking Reagent: sc-516214 and Western Blotting Luminol Reagent: sc-2048. 2) Immunofluorescence: use m-lgG κ BP-FITC: sc-516140 or m-lgG κ BP-PE: sc-516141 (dilution range: 1:50-1:200) with UltraCruz[®] Mounting Medium: sc-24941 or UltraCruz[®] Hard-set Mounting Medium: sc-359850.

RT-PCR REAGENTS

Semi-quantitative RT-PCR may be performed to monitor PI 3-kinase p110 δ gene expression knockdown using RT-PCR Primer: PI 3-kinase p110 δ (m)-PR: sc-39132-PR (20 μ I, 558 bp). Annealing temperature for the primers should be 55-60° C and the extension temperature should be 68-72° C.
