YSK1 siRNA (h): sc-39253



The Power to Question

BACKGROUND

Several mammalian kinases have been identified which exhibit sequence similarity to the *Saccharomyces cerevisiae* serine/threonine kinase STE20. STE20 is involved in relaying signals from G protein-coupled receptors, and it lies upstream of a MAP kinase kinase kinase. Mammalian STE20-like kinases include YSK1, KHS, GLK, NIK, HPK1, Krs-1, Krs-2 and GC kinase. YSK1 (yeast SPS/STE20-related kinase 1) is expressed in a wide variety of cell types and tissues and has been shown to have kinase activity. Unlike many of the other STE20-like kinases, however, overexpression of YSK1 does not lead to activation of the SAPK/JNK pathway.

CHROMOSOMAL LOCATION

Genetic locus: STK25 (human) mapping to 2q37.3.

PRODUCT

YSK1 siRNA (h) is a pool of 3 target-specific 19-25 nt siRNAs designed to knock down gene expression. Each vial contains 3.3 nmol of lyophilized siRNA, sufficient for a 10 μM solution once resuspended using protocol below. Suitable for 50-100 transfections. Also see YSK1 shRNA Plasmid (h): sc-39253-SH and YSK1 shRNA (h) Lentiviral Particles: sc-39253-V as alternate gene silencing products.

For independent verification of YSK1 (h) gene silencing results, we also provide the individual siRNA duplex components. Each is available as 3.3 nmol of lyophilized siRNA. These include: sc-39253A, sc-39253B and sc-39253C.

STORAGE AND RESUSPENSION

Store lyophilized siRNA duplex at -20° C with desiccant. Stable for at least one year from the date of shipment. Once resuspended, store at -20° C, avoid contact with RNAses and repeated freeze thaw cycles.

Resuspend lyophilized siRNA duplex in 330 μ l of the RNAse-free water provided. Resuspension of the siRNA duplex in 330 μ l of RNAse-free water makes a 10 μ M solution in a 10 μ M Tris-HCl, pH 8.0, 20 mM NaCl, 1 mM EDTA buffered solution.

APPLICATIONS

YSK1 siRNA (h) is recommended for the inhibition of YSK1 expression in human cells.

SUPPORT REAGENTS

For optimal siRNA transfection efficiency, Santa Cruz Biotechnology's siRNA Transfection Reagent: sc-29528 (0.3 ml), siRNA Transfection Medium: sc-36868 (20 ml) and siRNA Dilution Buffer: sc-29527 (1.5 ml) are recommended. Control siRNAs or Fluorescein Conjugated Control siRNAs are available as 10 µM in 66 µl. Each contain a scrambled sequence that will not lead to the specific degradation of any known cellular mRNA. Fluorescein Conjugated Control siRNAs include: sc-36869, sc-44239, sc-44240 and sc-44241. Control siRNAs include: sc-37007, sc-44230, sc-44231, sc-44232, sc-44233, sc-44234, sc-44235, sc-44236, sc-44237 and sc-44238.

GENE EXPRESSION MONITORING

YSK1 (E-5): sc-271196 is recommended as a control antibody for monitoring of YSK1 gene expression knockdown by Western Blotting (starting dilution 1:200, dilution range 1:100-1:1000) or immunofluorescence (starting dilution 1:50, dilution range 1:50-1:500).

To ensure optimal results, the following support reagents are recommended: 1) Western Blotting: use m-lgG κ BP-HRP: sc-516102 or m-lgG κ BP-HRP (Cruz Marker): sc-516102-CM (dilution range: 1:1000-1:10000), Cruz MarkerTM Molecular Weight Standards: sc-2035, UltraCruz[®] Blocking Reagent: sc-516214 and Western Blotting Luminol Reagent: sc-2048. 2) Immunofluorescence: use m-lgG κ BP-FITC: sc-516140 or m-lgG κ BP-PE: sc-516141 (dilution range: 1:50-1:200) with UltraCruz[®] Mounting Medium: sc-24941 or UltraCruz[®] Hard-set Mounting Medium: sc-359850.

RT-PCR REAGENTS

Semi-quantitative RT-PCR may be performed to monitor YSK1 gene expression knockdown using RT-PCR Primer: YSK1 (h)-PR: sc-39253-PR (20 μ I, 578 bp). Annealing temperature for the primers should be 55-60° C and the extension temperature should be 68-72° C.

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
