# IL-1RII siRNA (h): sc-72042



The Power to Question

## **BACKGROUND**

Decoy receptors are structurally incapable of activating signaling pathways, but act as anti-inflammatory agents by sequestering agonists for actual signaling complexes. The type II IL-1 receptor (IL-1RII) acts as a decoy receptor for the chemokine interleukin-1 (IL-1). Additionally, the soluble form of IL-1R accessory protein (IL-1R AcP) increases the affinity of binding of IL-1 $\alpha$  and IL-1 $\beta$  to IL-1RII 100-fold, but does not increase the affinity for another anti-inflammatory agent, IL-1R antagonist (IL-1ra). The end result is a complex regulatory mechanism for IL-1 activated inflammation, whereby dexamethasone and other molecules inducing IL-1RII, function in an immunosupressive and anti-inflammatory manner.

# CHROMOSOMAL LOCATION

Genetic locus: IL1R2 (human) mapping to 2q11.2.

## **PRODUCT**

IL-1RII siRNA (h) is a pool of 3 target-specific 19-25 nt siRNAs designed to knock down gene expression. Each vial contains 3.3 nmol of lyophilized siRNA, sufficient for a 10  $\mu$ M solution once resuspended using protocol below. Suitable for 50-100 transfections. Also see IL-1RII shRNA Plasmid (h): sc-72042-SH and IL-1RII shRNA (h) Lentiviral Particles: sc-72042-V as alternate gene silencing products.

For independent verification of IL-1RII (h) gene silencing results, we also provide the individual siRNA duplex components. Each is available as 3.3 nmol of lyophilized siRNA. These include: sc-72042A, sc-72042B and sc-72042C.

#### STORAGE AND RESUSPENSION

Store lyophilized siRNA duplex at -20° C with desiccant. Stable for at least one year from the date of shipment. Once resuspended, store at -20° C, avoid contact with RNAses and repeated freeze thaw cycles.

Resuspend lyophilized siRNA duplex in 330  $\mu$ l of the RNAse-free water provided. Resuspension of the siRNA duplex in 330  $\mu$ l of RNAse-free water makes a 10  $\mu$ M solution in a 10  $\mu$ M Tris-HCl, pH 8.0, 20 mM NaCl, 1 mM EDTA buffered solution.

## **APPLICATIONS**

IL-1RII siRNA (h) is recommended for the inhibition of IL-1RII expression in human cells.

#### **SUPPORT REAGENTS**

For optimal siRNA transfection efficiency, Santa Cruz Biotechnology's siRNA Transfection Reagent: sc-29528 (0.3 ml), siRNA Transfection Medium: sc-36868 (20 ml) and siRNA Dilution Buffer: sc-29527 (1.5 ml) are recommended. Control siRNAs or Fluorescein Conjugated Control siRNAs are available as 10 µM in 66 µl. Each contain a scrambled sequence that will not lead to the specific degradation of any known cellular mRNA. Fluorescein Conjugated Control siRNAs include: sc-36869, sc-44239, sc-44240 and sc-44241. Control siRNAs include: sc-37007, sc-44230, sc-44231, sc-44232, sc-44233, sc-44234, sc-44235, sc-44236, sc-44237 and sc-44238.

## **GENE EXPRESSION MONITORING**

IL-1RII (G-5): sc-376247 is recommended as a control antibody for monitoring of IL-1RII gene expression knockdown by Western Blotting (starting dilution 1:200, dilution range 1:100-1:1000) or immunofluorescence (starting dilution 1:50, dilution range 1:50-1:500).

To ensure optimal results, the following support (secondary) reagents are recommended: 1) Western Blotting: use goat anti-mouse IgG-HRP: sc-2005 (dilution range: 1:2000-1:32,000) or Cruz Marker™ compatible goat anti-mouse IgG-HRP: sc-2031 (dilution range: 1:2000-1:5000), Cruz Marker™ Molecular Weight Standards: sc-2035, TBS Blotto A Blocking Reagent: sc-2333 and Western Blotting Luminol Reagent: sc-2048. 2) Immunofluorescence: use goat anti-mouse IgG-FITC: sc-2010 (dilution range: 1:100-1:400) or goat anti-mouse IgG-TR: sc-2781 (dilution range: 1:100-1:400) with UltraCruz™ Mounting Medium: sc-24941.

## **RT-PCR REAGENTS**

Semi-quantitative RT-PCR may be performed to monitor IL-1RII gene expression knockdown using RT-PCR Primer: IL-1RII (h)-PR: sc-72042-PR (20  $\mu$ l). Annealing temperature for the primers should be 55-60° C and the extension temperature should be 68-72° C.
