



DCAMKL3 siRNA (h): sc-78120

BACKGROUND

The phosphorylation and dephosphorylation of proteins on serine and threonine residues is an essential means of regulating a broad range of cellular functions in eukaryotes, including cell division, homeostasis and apoptosis. A group of proteins that are intimately involved in this process are the serine/threonine (Ser/Thr) protein kinases. DCAMKL3 (doublecortin-like and CAM kinase-like 3), also known as DCLK3 or DCDC3C, is a 648 amino acid protein that localizes to both the nucleus and the cytoplasm and contains one protein kinase domain. One of several members of the Ser/Thr protein kinase family, DCAMKL3 functions to catalyze the ATP-dependent attachment of a phospho residue to target proteins, an event that may play a role in various cellular processes.

CHROMOSOMAL LOCATION

Genetic locus: DCLK3 (human) mapping to 3p22.2.

PRODUCT

DCAMKL3 siRNA (h) is a pool of 3 target-specific 19-25 nt siRNAs designed to knock down gene expression. Each vial contains 3.3 nmol of lyophilized siRNA, sufficient for a 10 μ M solution once resuspended using protocol below. Suitable for 50-100 transfections. Also see DCAMKL3 shRNA Plasmid (h): sc-78120-SH and DCAMKL3 shRNA (h) Lentiviral Particles: sc-78120-V as alternate gene silencing products.

For independent verification of DCAMKL3 (h) gene silencing results, we also provide the individual siRNA duplex components. Each is available as 3.3 nmol of lyophilized siRNA. These include: sc-78120A, sc-78120B and sc-78120C.

STORAGE AND RESUSPENSION

Store lyophilized siRNA duplex at -20° C with desiccant. Stable for at least one year from the date of shipment. Once resuspended, store at -20° C, avoid contact with RNAses and repeated freeze thaw cycles.

Resuspend lyophilized siRNA duplex in 330 μ l of the RNase-free water provided. Resuspension of the siRNA duplex in 330 μ l of RNase-free water makes a 10 μ M solution in a 10 μ M Tris-HCl, pH 8.0, 20 mM NaCl, 1 mM EDTA buffered solution.

APPLICATIONS

DCAMKL3 siRNA (h) is recommended for the inhibition of DCAMKL3 expression in human cells.

SUPPORT REAGENTS

For optimal siRNA transfection efficiency, Santa Cruz Biotechnology's siRNA Transfection Reagent: sc-29528 (0.3 ml), siRNA Transfection Medium: sc-36868 (20 ml) and siRNA Dilution Buffer: sc-29527 (1.5 ml) are recommended. Control siRNAs or Fluorescein Conjugated Control siRNAs are available as 10 μ M in 66 μ l. Each contain a scrambled sequence that will not lead to the specific degradation of any known cellular mRNA. Fluorescein Conjugated Control siRNAs include: sc-36869, sc-44239, sc-44240 and sc-44241. Control siRNAs include: sc-37007, sc-44230, sc-44231, sc-44232, sc-44233, sc-44234, sc-44235, sc-44236, sc-44237 and sc-44238.

RT-PCR REAGENTS

Semi-quantitative RT-PCR may be performed to monitor DCAMKL3 gene expression knockdown using RT-PCR Primer: DCAMKL3 (h)-PR: sc-78120-PR (20 μ l). Annealing temperature for the primers should be 55-60° C and the extension temperature should be 68-72° C.
