ZNF446 siRNA (h): sc-97865



The Power to Question

BACKGROUND

Zinc-finger proteins contain DNA-binding domains and have a wide variety of functions, most of which encompass some form of transcriptional activation or repression. As a member of the Krüppel C_2H_2 -type zinc-finger protein family, ZNF446 (zinc finger protein 446), also known as znc finger and SCAN domain-containing protein 20 (ZKSCAN20), is a 450 amino acid transcriptional regulator. ZNF446 localizes to the nucleus and is expressed in a variety of human adult tissues with the highest expression level in muscle. ZNF446 contains three C_2H_2 -type zinc fingers, a SCAN domain and a KRAB domain. ZNF446 functions as a transcriptional repressor for SRE (serum response element) and c-Jun transcription factors and may play a critical role in cell growth and proliferation signaling pathways.

Genetic locus: ZNF446 (human) mapping to 19q13.43.

PRODUCT

ZNF446 siRNA (h) is a pool of 2 target-specific 19-25 nt siRNAs designed to knock down gene expression. Each vial contains 3.3 nmol of lyophilized siRNA, sufficient for a 10 μM solution once resuspended using protocol below. Suitable for 50-100 transfections. Also see ZNF446 shRNA Plasmid (h): sc-97865-SH and ZNF446 shRNA (h) Lentiviral Particles: sc-97865-V as alternate gene silencing products.

For independent verification of ZNF446 (h) gene silencing results, we also provide the individual siRNA duplex components. Each is available as 3.3 nmol of lyophilized siRNA. These include: sc-97865A and sc-97865B.

STORAGE AND RESUSPENSION

Store lyophilized siRNA duplex at -20° C with desiccant. Stable for at least one year from the date of shipment. Once resuspended, store at -20° C, avoid contact with RNAses and repeated freeze thaw cycles.

Resuspend lyophilized siRNA duplex in 330 μ l of the RNAse-free water provided. Resuspension of the siRNA duplex in 330 μ l of RNAse-free water makes a 10 μ M solution in a 10 μ M Tris-HCl, pH 8.0, 20 mM NaCl, 1 mM EDTA buffered solution.

APPLICATIONS

ZNF446 siRNA (h) is recommended for the inhibition of ZNF446 expression in human cells.

SUPPORT REAGENTS

For optimal siRNA transfection efficiency, Santa Cruz Biotechnology's siRNA Transfection Reagent: sc-29528 (0.3 ml), siRNA Transfection Medium: sc-36868 (20 ml) and siRNA Dilution Buffer: sc-29527 (1.5 ml) are recommended. Control siRNAs or Fluorescein Conjugated Control siRNAs are available as 10 µM in 66 µl. Each contain a scrambled sequence that will not lead to the specific degradation of any known cellular mRNA. Fluorescein Conjugated Control siRNAs include: sc-36869, sc-44239, sc-44240 and sc-44241. Control siRNAs include: sc-37007, sc-44230, sc-44231, sc-44232, sc-44233, sc-44234, sc-44235, sc-44236, sc-44237 and sc-44238.

RT-PCR REAGENTS

Semi-quantitative RT-PCR may be performed to monitor ZNF446 gene expression knockdown using RT-PCR Primer: ZNF446 (h)-PR: sc-97865-PR (20 μ l). Annealing temperature for the primers should be 55-60° C and the extension temperature should be 68-72° C.

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
